

# How to Sort and Dispose of Resources and Garbage Properly

Up to three 45ℓ garbage bags per collection  
(A collection fee is charged for disposal of four or more bags)

Please take your recyclable resources, burnable trash and non-burnable trash to your designated collection site by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day (7:30 a.m. for shopping/entertainment districts).

The time and place of the collection may be changed due to change in destination, road construction, revision in routes.

Combustible  
(Burnable)  
Waste  
Twice a week

Biodegradable Trash

Kitchen scraps, dam shells, egg shells, etc.

Plastic Items

Styrofoam products, plastic food wrap, plastic vinyl, CD, video tape, etc.

Clothes, Wood Scraps

Blended fabrics, small amounts of wood scraps

Rubber Items

Garden hoses, sandals, etc.

Paper Scraps

Tissue, disposable diapers, etc.

Leather Items

Briefcases, shoes, leather clothes, etc.

Place items in containers with lids or in transparent bags.

- Drain kitchen scraps of water before disposal.
- Absorb cooking oil using paper or cloth or with a solidifying agent.
- When disposing of bamboo skewers, please wrap them in paper with the words "キケン" clearly written on the wrapping.

There is a fee for the collection of large amounts of tree and hedge trimmings (branches, etc). Please contact the Waste Collection Office.

A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.

Incombustible  
(Non-burnable)  
Waste  
Once a month

Metal items, glass products, ceramics/pottery, batteries, etc.

\* Broken fluorescent tubes, incandescent light bulbs and LEDs are considered incombustible waste.

Electrical appliances measuring less than 30 cm on any side.

Place items in containers with lids or in transparent bags so that the contents can be seen.

- When disposing of sharp objects, such as glass, needles and cutting instruments, wrap them carefully in paper with the words "キケン" clearly written on the wrapping.
- Dispose rechargeable batteries and button batteries in collection boxes set in electronics stores, etc.

A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.

Disposal Method

- 1 Remove bottle caps and labels.
- 2 Rinse the inside with water.
- 3 Squash the bottles.
- 4 Place the bottles in transparent bags and dispose of them in the designated collection site.

\* Dispose of caps and labels as burnable trash.

Cardboard

\*Please dispose paper egg trays as combustible waste

Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:

Envelopes with glassine windows, thermal paper, non-carbon paper, photographs, paper cups, plastic-coated paper, paper cosmetics boxes, Milk cartons

Separate recyclable paper according to type and bundle with string before disposal.

- You can dispose of fliers inserted in newspapers together with your newspapers.
- Collection is conducted on rainy days as well.

A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.

Bottles

Glass bottles for foods and beverages

\* Plum liqueur bottles are also accepted

Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:

Cosmetics bottles, bottles for oil, glasses, cups, ceramics/pottery, products made from heat-resistant glass, broken bottles

Place bottles and cans in separate transparent bags each so that the contents can be seen. The bags will not be collected if the contents are not separated.

- Rinse the inside before disposing of cans and bottles.
- Take "returnable" bottles, such as beer bottles and "ishho" bottles for sake back to the store of purchase.

A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.

Aluminum/steel cans for foods and beverages

\*Snack cans are also accepted

Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:

Cans for oil, cans for paint

Dispose of spray cans and cassette gas cylinders after they are completely empty. Please separate the contents and ensure that the bags are clearly labelled.

A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.

Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:

Please dispose aerosol paint cans as incombustible waste

Fluorescent tubes

Circular Compact Straight tube

Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:

Fluorescent LED tubes (compact, circular and straight tube), broken fluorescent tubes and incandescent light bulbs are considered incombustible waste.

Please place the fluorescent tube in its original packaging, or wrap it in paper to prevent it from breaking before disposal.

From July 2018, we will begin collecting fluorescent tubes containing mercury as recyclables.

- Please dispose of LEDs, incandescent light bulbs and broken fluorescent tubes as incombustible waste.

Gas/Kerosene Appliances, Furniture, Bedding and Other Items

Futons, kerosene stoves, bicycles, fixtures, etc. (objects with edges approximately 30cm long or more)

Please remove the lighting fixtures and fluorescent lamps attached to desks before disposal.

(1) When you make a reservation of collection, confirm the collection date and fee, and purchase Large-sized Trash Fee Stickers.  
(2) Write your name on the stickers, attach them to your trash, and take the items to be collected outside by 8:00 a.m. on the designated collection day.

- Do not dispose of appliance(s) in the collection site designated for regular garbage collection.

Business-generated large-sized trash cannot be collected by the city. The city will introduce you to a specialized company.

Electric Appliances  
Designated for Recycling  
A collection fee is charged

Air Conditioners, TVs, Refrigerators/Freezers and Washing Machines (drying machine)

Ask the store of purchase to handle your used item.

When you make a reservation for collection, confirm the collection date, collection/transportation fee and recycling fee (for house hold appliances recycling coupons)

- Items sold as household appliances are eligible.
- These items will not be collected by the Shibuya City Waste Collection Office. Please do not dispose these items in the collection site designated for regular garbage collection.

The following items are not collected by the city.

- \* Mobile phones, PHS, fire extinguishers, cars, and motorcycles will be collected and recycled by the manufacturer.
- \* Batteries, tires, kerosene items, paints, pianos, safes, chemicals, and sharp medical tools, etc.  
For disposal of these items, contact the store of purchase or ask a specialized company.  
(The Waste Collection Office can introduce you to a specialized company that will help you.)

Personal Computers are collected and recycled by the manufacturer.

- To make reservation for collection, contact the manufacturer of the personal computer.  
If you do not know the contact information of the manufacturer, check through PC3R Promotion Association.

- Garbage is collected on regularly scheduled days, including national holidays, except during the year-end/New Year holidays and on Sundays.
- All business-generated trash, including recyclable resources, is collected for a fee. (Please affix the proper amount of stickers before disposal.)

Personal computers that do not have PC Recycling Mark on it (those bought before October 1st, 2003), collection and recycling fees will be required.
