

Recycling plant in Japan

Sorted, cleaned, melted down and formed into small pellets (granules) for product materials

The process of making recyclables into products

Recyclable items are collected, (1) sorted(to remove unacceptable items by hand), (2) compressed/packed (to facilitate delivery), then transported to the recycling plant and formed into materials of new products.





Once a week

- Please clean the recyclable items and sort them by type, then take them to the recyclables collection station.
- Be sure to put them out before 8 a.m. on the collection day.
- The pickup time and collection vehicles vary depending on the type of recyclable items.
- Pick up service for the elderly: If your household has only elderly people (70+) or people with physical disabilities and you cannot take the recyclables to the station, please contact Shinagawa City Waste Collection Office.

Packaging of plastic containers

Packaging of plastic containers refers to the plastics that will be unnecessary when you use up the contents.




Sort

Please empty and rinse plastics, put them in a Clear Bag, then take them to the recyclable collection station.

*Packaging of plastic containers with hard-to-remove dirt and plastic products such as toys, stationeries, and general goods are collected as Combustible Waste (see page 7)



Plastic bottles, glass bottles, cans



Remove the caps and labels and put them into packaging of plastic containers (see page 3)



Remove the caps, sort them by material and put them into ceramics, glass, metal waste (see page 8) or packaging of plastic containers (see page 3)



Ring pulls and caps can remain on cans

Sort

Rinse items, separate them into plastic bottles. glass bottles or cans, and put these into separate clear bags or containers.

Please take 1.8L bottles and beer bottles to the shop where you purchased them. *Oil bottles, and bottles for other than food and beverages (e.g., cosmetics bottles) should be put into ceramics, glass, metal waste. (see page 8)



Other recyclable paper

Other recyclable paper is:

paper that is to be the raw material for recycled paper, such as confectionery boxes, tissue boxes, paper bags, brochures, copy paper, wrapping papers, calendars, envelopes, and so on.





Remove the plastic, and put it into packaging of plastic containers (see page 3)



Remove the handle if it is not paper. put it in combustible waste (see page 7)



Remove the metal part, put it in ceramics, glass, metal waste (see page 8)

Sort

Separate the items by type and tie them with string or put them in a paper bag.


Put the item in the original box or wrap it in a newspaper or paper to avoid damage. Please place it horizontally at the recyclable collection station so that it does not break.


Please wrap the item in a newspaper or paper if it is broken, and label it with "キケン" (danger).








Products containing mercury cannot be processed at the incineration plant. Please be sure to separate them.

The group comprises residents involved in a town or community association, condominium management association, PTA, etc. The group determines the pickup date, time, and site for the voluntary collection of household recyclables, and passes them on to the waste collection providers. 
Combustible Waste

(Pickup at house-to-house)

Twice a week

Put the waste in a Clear Bag that allows the contents to be seen.

- Also when you put the waste in bins with lids, put it in a Clear Bag that allows the contents to be seen.
- Up to 4 x 45-L bags per household can be put out for each collection.



If you are a resident in a flat, please put your waste out at the designated place within the grounds of the building. If you are a resident in a detached house, please put your waste out at the designated place, such as in front of your house entrance or a gate.

*If you have moved into Shinagawa City, please contact Shinagawa City Waste Collection Office.

- Be sure put the waste out before 8 a.m. on the collection day. Please put the waste out before 7:30 a.m. in the early morning collection area.
- Waste with a length longer than 30 cm will be collected as bulky waste.




